School Trips

Taking our young people out on school trips and community visits help young people solidify and recall information by applying what they've learned in the classroom to real-world experiences. School trips can help students build confidence and self-esteem. One study found that 87% of school students felt more confident trying new things on a school trip. They help students develop critical skills like negotiation, problem-solving, and working together. They can also help students make new friends and develop class relationships. School trips can help teachers see how their students learn and view the world, which can generate ideas for the classroom. They can also help teachers identify staff strengths and skills that may not have been evident in the classroom.



Last week 2 of our classes visited a local park and I am looking forward to arranging our first school visit to the theatre to watch Beauty and The Beast as an end of term treat – this also links with their current learning in English lessons.
