**Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December:** School is closed for INSET (Staff Training)

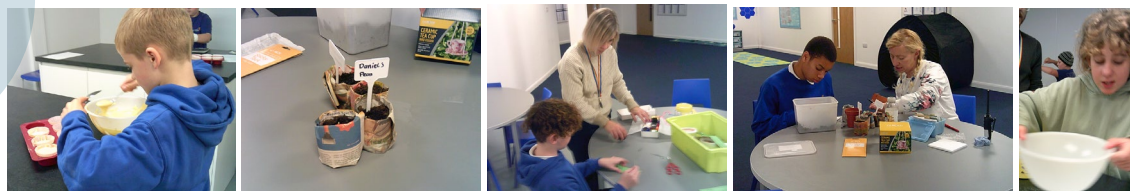
## Uniform
